


## Index of turnover in industry

2017, January

# Turnover in manufacturing increased by 7.7 per cent in November to January

According to Statistics Finland, turnover in manufacturing in the November to January period was 7.7 per cent higher than in the corresponding period of the year before. Domestic sales grew by 9.4 per cent and export turnover by 6.6 per cent from one year ago.


### Three months' year-on-year change in turnover in manufacturing (C) sub-industries (TOL 2008)

Turnover grew for the first time in nearly six years in all **manufacturing (C) sub-industries** from the corresponding period of the previous year. Turnover grew most in the chemical industry, by 13.4 per cent, in the textile, clothing and leather industry, by 8.8 per cent, and in the forest industry, by 7.7 per cent. The growth was slowest in the food industry, 1.3 per cent, and in the electrical and electronics industry, 2.3 per cent.

The turnover of all **other main categories of manufacturing industries** also grew year-on-year. Turnover grew strongest in the industry of mining and quarrying, 30.9 per cent. Turnover in water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased by 7.0 per cent, and in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 4.1 per cent from one year before.

The index of turnover in industry describes enterprises whose main industry is manufacturing. The calculation of the indices is based on the Tax Administration's self-assessed tax data which are supplemented with data obtained with Statistics Finland's sales inquiry. The monthly turnovers of manufacturing enterprises can vary considerably, especially in the metal industries. The variation is mainly due to invoicing practices. The final invoice for major machinery deliveries and projects may be recorded in the sales of one month, even if the delivery had required the work of several months or years.

## Changes in the Tax Administration's self-assessed tax data do not have an effect on the data of turnover indices for January 2017

The effects of the changes in the Tax Administration's self-assessed tax data have been analysed in Statistics Finland's turnover indices. Based on the analyses, no significant changes for statistics production were observed in the value added tax reporting of enterprises. More about this under <u>Changes in these statistics</u>.





Appendix figure 1. Trend series on total turnover, domestic turnover and export turnover in manufacturing





## Appendix figure 2. Trend series on total turnover, domestic turnover and export turnover in the forest industry




